APPELLATION:	Sta. Rita Hills
COMPOSITION:	100% Pinot Noir Clone: 113, 777, Pommard
PRODUCTION:	129 Cases
VINEYARD:	Turner Vineyard is located in the Sta. Rita Hills. It was planted in 2000 by Ryan Carr with 15 acres of Pinot Noir, three acres of Pinot Gris, and three acres of Syrah. 2004 was the first harvest for the vineyard. The harvest was only one ton to the acre and each vine had no more than six of the most beautiful small, tight clusters on it.
WINEMAKING:	This pinot noir was aged 12 months in French oak barrels.
TASTING NOTES:	The 2004 Carr Pinot Noir is a very elegant wine. It is medium-bodied with aromas of red currants, sweet cherries and only a touch of spice. The wine has ripe stone fruit and berry flavors.
