VINEYARD:	Planted in 2000 by Ryan Carr, Turner Vineyard is a twenty one acre vineyard located in the northern part of the Sta. Rita Hills appellation. The vineyard is planted with one and a half acres of Syrah, three acres of Pinot Gris, one and a half acres of Chardonnay and fifteen acres of Pinot Noir. The Pinot Gris is grown in sandy soils in the valley floor section of the vineyard. This particular location paired with the cool climate of Sta. Rita Hills is the perfect site to grow Pinot Gris.
WINEMAKING:	Cold fermented in stainless steel and aged only five months.
TASTING NOTES:	This Pinot Gris has a full, floral nose and a delicate mouth-feel. Flavors of freshly picked apples and pears highlighted by light honey notes.
