The vineyard is organically farmed and produces beautiful grapes with vibrant color and depth. The vineyard includes one and a half acres of Syrah, three acres of Pinot Gris, one and a half acres of Chardonnay and fifteen acres of Pinot Noir.
WINEMAKING:	This Pinot Noir was aged for 15 months in French oak barrels, 15% new oak.
TASTING NOTES:	This Pinot Noir has aromas of vanilla and cherry pie. It has an amazing balance of fruit, spice, earth and minerality with hints of cranberry, chalk and subtle sassafras. The flavors coat your mouth and linger on the finish.
