VINEYARD:	This wine is made from the best grapes to come off Turner Vineyard; which is a twenty-one acre vineyard located in the Northern part of the Sta. Rita Hills appellation. The cool climate, south-facing slopes and sandy soils make it an ideal terroir for the renowned Pinot Noir. The vineyard produces beautiful grapes with vibrant color and depth. The vineyard includes one and a half acres of Syrah, three acres of Pinot Gris, one and a half acres of Chardonnay and fifteen acres of Pinot Noir.
WINEMAKING:	Made from Pinot Noir grapes, this Rosé was fermented in stainless steel which shines through in it's crisp dry finish. The wine had minimal contact with the skins of the grape to create the nice Rosé color.
TASTING NOTES:	This Pinot Noir Rosé is a dry wine with light pink and yellow hues. It has aromas of orange blossom and strawberry lead into similar flavors of strawberry watermelon and orange zest. This rosé has a balanced acidity with a slight minerality on the finish.
