WINEMAKING:	This Pinot was aged 12 months in French oak barrels, 15% new oak.
TASTING NOTES:	Combining the best fruit from two different vineyards in the Sta. Rita Hills, this mouth-watering Pinot Noir begins with candied red fruits and woody earth on the nose. These decadent aromas lead into a palate of mildly sweet raspberry jam and fully blossomed roses with a gentle finish of radish and root spice.
