VINEYARD:

Morehouse Vineyard is a small two acre vineyard located off Highway 246 in the center of Santa Ynez Valley. The vineyard is very unique because it has one of the last plantings of the Syrah Durell clone left in the area. The vines struggle in a silty, clay soil, producing a low yield with concentrated flavors. Morehouse Vineyard was established in 1990 by Brian Morehouse and in 2005, Ryan Carr took over the care of the vineyard.

WINEMAKING:

This Syrah was aged 18 months in French oak barrels, 20% new oak.

TASTING NOTES:

Morehouse Vineyard is very unique as it boasts one of the last plantings of the Syrah Durell clone left in the area. With initial hints of vanilla bean and blueberry pie, this wine is full bodied yet delicately smooth. Flavors of cedar and cocoa round

out the mellow and lasting finish.
