VINEYARD:	Paredon Vineyard is one of the few vineyards managed by Ryan Carr that is on the ocean side of the Santa Barbara mountain range. This vineyard is very unique because it sits at twelve hundred feet above sea level, creating the perfect climate for Grenache. The ocean breeze keeps the clusters cool while the reflection of the sun off the marine layer and sea far below ripen the grapes to perfection.
WINEMAKING:	This Grenache was aged 18 months in French oak barrels, 20% new oak.
TASTING NOTES:	Paredon Vineyard sits high up above the ocean in Carpinteria, California, producing Grenache quite unlike any other. This medium-bodied wine leads with notes of fresh cut strawberries and brown sugar. The mid palate is spicy, with gentle hints of vanilla extract. This wine finishes long and strong with full flavors of black pepper and red fruit. It is a truly unique wine that is not to be missed!
