VINEYARDS:

The Yard Vineyard is located in the Northern most section of the Sta. Rita Hills in Santa Barbara County. This vineyard was one of the first planted by Ryan Carr in 1998. The Yard is an eighteen acre vineyard planted in sandy loam soils. It is also the only spot in Sta. Rita Hills where we have found a heavy

limestone content in the soils.

WINEMAKING:

This Pinot Noir was aged for 12 months in French oak barrels, 15% new oak.

TASTING NOTES:

With both red fruit and natural earth qualities, this Pinot Noir is an excellent representation of wine from this appellation. Joined by hints of ceylon and clove, the palate opens up to distinct flavors of baked Fuji apples and fresh nutmeg. This follows through to the end, joined by the slightest

note of clove on the finish.
