VINEYARD:

Quail Ridge is a 3 acre vineyard owned by Joe Kalina. It is located in the center of the Santa Ynez Valley with steep south facing slopes and consists of Grenache and Syrah. The vineyard was planted in 1997 and Ryan Carr took over

the management of it in 2011.

WINEMAKING:

The Grenache and Syrah were co-fermented and then aged 18 months in French oak barrels, 20%

TASTING NOTES:

CrossHatch

These two varietals are co-fermented to produce a profound, deeply shaded garnet blend that exhibits aromas of ripe figs, dark licorice, and deep black fruits. The jammy black fruits flow through onto the palate and are accompanied by hints of spices, smoky white pepper and accented with mellow, earthy undertones.
