VINEYARD: This 2004 Pinot Grigio marks the first harvest of Turner Vineyard. The vineyard is a twenty-one acre vineyard located in the northern part of the Sta. Rita Hills appellation. The cool climate, south-facing slopes and sandy soils make it an ideal terroir. The vineyard produces beautiful grapes with vibrant color and depth. Turner Vineyard was established in 2000 by Dennis Turner, while planted and cultivated by Ryan Carr. The vineyard includes three acres of Syrah, three acres of Pinot Gris and fifteen acres of Pinot Noir.

WINEMAKING: This Pinot Gris was cold fermented and aged for five months in stainless steel.

TASTING NOTES: This wine has flavors of crisp green apples and spiced tea as fresh and intense like the day they were picked.
