VINEYARD:	Morehouse Vineyard is a small two acre vineyard located off Highway 246 in the center of the Santa Ynez Valley. The vineyard is very unique because it has one of the last plantings of the Syrah Durell clone left in the area. The vines struggle in a silty, clay soil producing a low yield with concentrated flavors. Morehouse Vineyard was established in 1990 by Brian Morehouse and in 2005, Ryan Carr took over the care of the vineyard.
WINEMAKING:	This Syrah was aged 18 months in French oak barrels, 25% new oak.
TASTING NOTES:	The 2011 Carr Syrah from Morehouse Vineyard is an elegant wine with deep ruby coloring. It starts off with a spicy nose along with a hints of plum and raspberry. Flavors of blackberry and plum follow on the palate with subtle underlying flavors of smoked bacon and cinnamon. It ends with a long lingering finish with a subtle spice and a touch of oak.
