VINEYARD: Paredon Vineyard is one of the few vineyards managed by Ryan Carr that is on the ocean side of the Santa Barbara mountain range. This vineyard is very unique because it sits at twelve hundred feet above sea level. This unique spot creates the perfect climate for Grenache. The ocean breeze keeps the clusters cool, while the reflection of sun off the marine layer and the sea far below ripen the grapes to perfection.

WINEMAKING: This Grenache was aged 18 months in French oak barrels, 20% new oak.

TASTING NOTES: This medium bodied Grenache starts off filling the glass with aromas of floral perfume with a tinge of forest floor. Flavors of black cherry and cedar on the front with black licorice and black pepper on the mid-palate and has a spicy finish with strong tannins.
