VINEYARDS: This Pinot Noir is a blend of Sta. Rita Hills and Santa Maria Valley fruit. The Santa Maria fruit produces a soft, light and silky Pinot Noir. The Sta. Rita Hills fruit produces a rich, dark and earthy Pinot Noir. Blending these appellations together creates a delicious wine that represents the extraordinary potential of Pinot Noir in Santa Barbara County.

WINEMAKING: This Pinot Noir was aged 12 months in French Oak barrels, 15% new oak.

TASTING NOTES: This classic Santa Barbara County Pinot Noir has lively aromas of raspberry and leather that open up flavors of black currants and mushroom. Subtle spice rounds out this well-balanced, complex wine with blueberry on the long finish.
