| VINEYARD: | Morehouse Vineyard is a small two acre vineyard located off Highway 246 in the center of the Santa Ynez Valley. The vineyard is very unique because it has one of the last plantings of the Syrah Durell clone left in the area. The vines struggle in a silty, clay soil producing a low yield with concentrated flavors. Morehouse Vineyard was established in 1990 by Brian Morehouse and in 2005, Ryan Carr took over the care of the vineyard. |
| WINEMAKING: | This Syrah was aged 18 months in French oak barrels, 25% new oak. |
| TASTING NOTES: | The 2012 Carr Syrah from Morehouse Vineyard has a wonderful aroma of baked blueberry cobbler with hints of chocolate and spice. The palate is spicy with flavors of blueberry, cassis and cocoa. |
