

# 2021 Carr Pinot Noir

PRODUCTION: 376 Cases

VINEYARD: This wine is made up of two vineyards from the Sta. Rita Hills AVA. Hilliard-Bruce Vineyard, planted by Ryan Carr in 2004, has 15 acres of Pinot Noir and 5 acres of Chardonnay. Kessler-Haak, planted in 2005, has 29 acres of Pinot Noir.

WINEMAKING: This Pinot Noir was aged for 20 months in neutral French oak barrels.

TASTING NOTES: An approachable yet complex Pinot Noir, this wine has aromas of pomegranate, black cherries and spice. The body is soft, with notes of plum and mulberry that finishes with bright acidity and silky tannins.
