PRODUCTION:	100 Cases
VINEYARD:	The Cabernet Franc comes from two vineyards. Camp Four Vineyard is planted in the far east end of the Santa Ynez Valley. Rossi is a high density vineyard planted in the Happy Canyon AVA. These areas of the valley have a very hot climate with many summer days that reach temperatures over 100 degrees, producing the perfect growing conditions for these grapes. The rocky soils of the foothills stress the vines into producing smaller
WINEMAKING:	This Cabernet Franc was fermented using 25% whole clusters, then aged for 32 months in French oak barrels, 25% new oak.
TASTING NOTES:	Aromas of red plum and light clove linger around this full bodied, reserve selection of Carr Cabernet Franc. Hints of raspberry and blackberry fill the initial palate leading into a robust and lengthy finish of cedar and nutmeg. This wine is hand-crafted from the four best barrels of the vintage and aged 32 months in French Oak, yielding a soft, gentle elegance and overall mouth-feel.
