VINEYARDS:	Santa Barbara County is known for producing some of the best Pinot Noirs in the world. The county consists of many different Pinot Noir vineyards and micro-climates. This wine is a blend of three vineyards in Sta. Rita Hills, which create a well balanced, complex wine that represents the extraordinary potential of Pinot Noir in Santa Barbara County.
WINEMAKING:	This Pinot was aged 12 months in French oak barrels, 15% new oak.
TASTING NOTES:	Fruit from two vineyards nested in the rolling slopes of the Sta. Rita Hills make up this delightfully, medium bodied Pinot Noir. This wine exudes aromas of tart boysenberries, black raspberries, and red fruits while still expressing small traces of woody earth on the nose as a result of its time in delicate French oak barrels. Ripe raspberries add a lusciously balanced acidity to the mellow, tannic finish of vanilla and subtle spices.
