VINEYARD:	Planted in 2000 by Ryan Carr, Turner Vineyard is a twenty one acre vineyard located in the northern part of the Sta. Rita Hills appellation. The vineyard is planted with one and a half acres of Syrah, three acres of Pinot Gris, one and a half acres of Chardonnay and fifteen acres of Pinot Noir. The Pinot Gris is grown in sandy soils in the valley floor section of the vineyard. This particular location paired with the cool climate of Sta. Rita Hills is the perfect site to grow Pinot Gris.
WINEMAKING:	Cold fermented in stainless steel and aged only five months.
TASTING NOTES:	Ripe yellow apples and soft, unsweetened cream introduce the palate of this medium bodied white wine. Tender notes of tropical fruit intermingle wonderfully with aromas of white roses and green apple. A pleasant minerality follows through the wine ending with a luscious, citrus finish.
