VINEYARD:	Located in Northern Santa Barbara County, near the western edge of the Santa Maria Valley, Sierra Madre Vineyard is the coldest vineyard in the state of California. The cold climate allows for a long growing season, and plenty of time for complexity in the fruit to develop. Sierra Madre Vineyard has become certified by the SIP program, recognizing that the vineyard adheres to sustainable farming practices. These practices include maintaining a diverse vineyard environment, soil conservation, natural pest management, ensuring pristine water and air quality, and use of organic pesticides, among other requirements.
WINEMAKING:	Cold fermented in stainless steel and aged only five months.
TASTING NOTES:	Aromas of green apple and spiced black tea lead on this Pinot Gris from Sierra Madre Vineyard. Cheery notes of ripe yellow pear and juicy white melon open up on the palate, followed by a bright and refreshing finish.
