VINEYARD:	Gypsy Canyon is a tiny historic vineyard of winemaker, Deborah Hall. This ancient Mission grape vineyard is the oldest producing vineyard in Santa Barbara County and located in an exceptionally cool microclimate in the Sta. Rita Hills which provides Pinot Noir grapes with a rare combination of full ripeness, concentration and excellent structure.
WINEMAKING:	The grapes are delicately hand rolled, with the stems left on. This process allows the vibrant, naturally present flavors to be gently extracted from the heart of the grapes. It is then aged 18 months in 1-2 year old French oak barrels.
TASTING NOTES:	This Pinot Noir was made with 100% whole clusters, yielding a deep, rich color, as well as inviting aromas of dark cherries and hints of mineral and herbal notes.
