VINEYARD:	Hilliard Bruce Vineyard is located in the Sta. Rita Hills appellation of Santa Barbara County. First planted in 2004 by Ryan Carr, the vineyard now has fifteen acres of Pinot Noir, and five acres of Chardonnay. The 2018 harvest was just over two tons to the acre making the fruit rich and full of flavor.
WINEMAKING:	This Pinot Noir was aged 24 months in French oak barrels.
TASTING NOTES:	This Pinot Noir from Hilliard Bruce Vineyard in Sta. Rita Hills has a beautiful ruby color. Luscious aromas of blackberry, butterscotch, and vanilla spice are followed by mixed berries, a touch of earthiness, and a silky, smooth finish.
