| VINEYARD:      | This wine is made up of two vineyards<br>from the Santa Rita Hills AVA.<br>Hilliard-Bruce Vineyard, planted by<br>Ryan Carr in 2004, has 15 acres of Pinot Noir<br>and 5 acre of Chardonnay.<br>Kessler-Haak, planted in 2005, has 29 acres<br>of Pinot Noir.                              |
| WINEMAKING:    | This Pinot Noir was made with 100% whole clusters. The grapes were delicately hand rolled with the stems left on allowing the vibrant and naturally present flavors to be gently extracted from the heart of the grapes. It is then aged 18 months in neutral French oak barrels.          |
| TASTING NOTES: | This luxurious Pinot Noir is complex,<br>full bodied and delicious. Aromas of baked<br>blackberry and cranberry leap from the glass.<br>The body is rich, with notes of red plum,<br>cherry and baking spices. The finish is lean,<br>with soft acidity, vanilla and a granite minerality. |
