

# 2020 Carr Pinot Noir, 667

Hilliard Bruce Vineyard, Sta. Rita Hills



VINTAGE: 2020

APPELLATION: Sta. Rita Hills

COMPOSITION: 100% 667 clone  
Clone 667 is one of the Dijon clones  
It is characterized by small berries, which  
result in a more intense color than many Pinot  
Noirs, and good tannin structure suitable for  
aging.

PRODUCTION: 102 cases

VINEYARD: Hilliard Bruce Vineyard is located in the Sta.  
Rita Hills appellation of Santa Barbara County.  
First planted in 2004 by Ryan Carr, the vineyard  
now has fifteen acres of Pinot Noir, and five  
acres of Chardonnay. The 2018 harvest was  
just over two tons to the acre making the  
fruit rich and full of flavor.

WINEMAKING: Aged 18 months in French oak barrels

TASTING NOTES: This clone is known for producing deep,  
dark colors and rich, fruitful flavors. The  
wine has aromas of raspberries and spice  
followed by rich, earthy tones and a smooth  
long finish.
