VINEYARD:

This wine is made from the best grapes to come off Turner Vineyard, which is a twenty-one acre vineyard located in the Northern part of the Sta. Rita Hills appellation. The cool climate, south-facing slopes and sandy soils make it an ideal terroir for the renowned Pinot Noir. The vineyard is organically farmed and produces beautiful grapes with vibrant color and depth.

WINEMAKING:

The grapes are delicately hand rolled, with the stems left on. This process allows the vibrant, naturally present flavors to be gently extracted from the heart of the grapes. It is then aged 12 months in French oak barrels, 15% new oak.

TASTING NOTES:

This wine yields a deep, rich color and exhibits well-rounded aromas of baked and dried red fruits such as cherries and ripened raspberries. Initial flavors of tart red apples, subtle citrus, and berries transform into soothing herbal mouth-feel on this medium bodied wine, rolling into a smooth, silky, and delicate finish.
